Cabinet Resolution No (8) of 2014 Concerning Licence Fees and Services Provided by the Federal Authority for Nuclear Regulation

The Cabinet,

- Having reviewed the Constitution;
- Federal Law No (1) of 1972 Concerning the Functions of Ministries and Powers of Ministers as amended;
- Federal Law by Decree No (6) of 2009 Concerning the Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy;
- Federal Law (1) of 2011 Concerning the State Public Revenues; and
- In accordance with the proposal of the Minister of Finance and the approval of the Cabinet,

Has decided the following:

Article (1)

The terms and phrases stated in this Resolution shall have the meanings ascribed to them in Article (1) of the Federal Law by Decree No. (6) of 2009 Concerning the Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy, unless the context requires otherwise.

Article (2)

1. At the beginning of each financial year following the date on which this Resolution comes into force, annual fees shall be imposed on Licensees to conduct Regulated Activities relating to a Nuclear Facility which shall be set at 90% of the approved FANR's budget for that financial year.
2. The fees, referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article, shall cover regulatory and control activities carried out by FANR and any Licences issued for Licensees to conduct any Regulated Activity relating to a Nuclear Facility except fees for issuing other Licences specified in the schedules attached to this Resolution.

The annual fees referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article shall be divided, in case of multiple Licensees, among the Licensees to conduct any Regulated Activity relating to a Nuclear Facility, as determined by the Ministry of Finance in accordance with a recommendation by the Board



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Article (3)

1. The fees specified in the schedules attached to this Resolution, shall be imposed on the Licensees for the services of issuing and renewing Licences to conduct Regulated Activities relating to Regulated Materials and for the purposes specified in the said schedules.
2. The duration of the Licence referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article shall be three years.

Article (4)

The Cabinet shall have the authority to introduce any amendments to the fees stated in this Resolution, whether it is an addition, deletion or amendment.

Article (5)

The fees stated in this Resolution shall be collected as determined by the Ministry of Finance in this regard.

Article (6)

The Chairman shall issue the necessary procedures to implement this Resolution in coordination with the Minister of Finance.

Article (7)

This Resolution shall be published in the Official Gazette and shall come into force the next day following its date of publication.

2. Industrial radiography X-ray units	Industrial radiography	5000	+1000 for 2-10 units; +1000 for 11-20; +3000 for 21 or greater.
3. Enclosed X-ray analysis units	Analysis	2000	+200 for each additional unit
4. Sealed radioactive sources and neutron generators	Well logging	5000	+4000 for >10 sources/generators
5. Sealed radioactive sources	Fixed gauges	2000	+1000 for >10 sources
6. Sealed radioactive sources	Mobile gauges	3000	+1000 for >10 sources
7. Sealed radioactive sources	Irradiator	5000	+ 5000 for each irradiator
8. Unsealed radioactive sources	Tracer studies	3000	None
